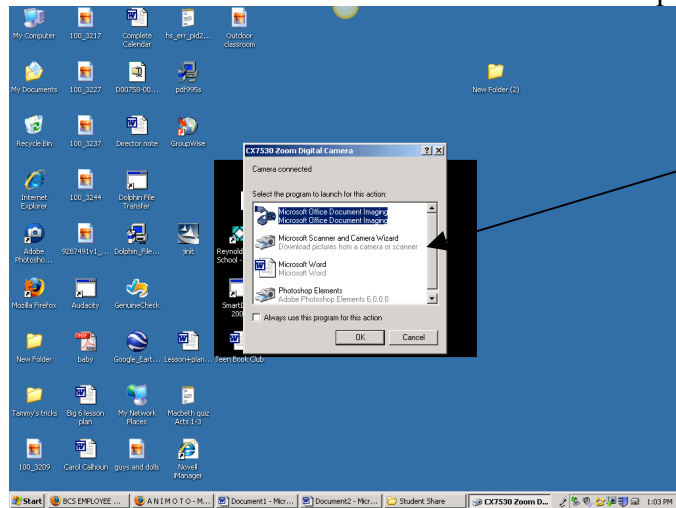
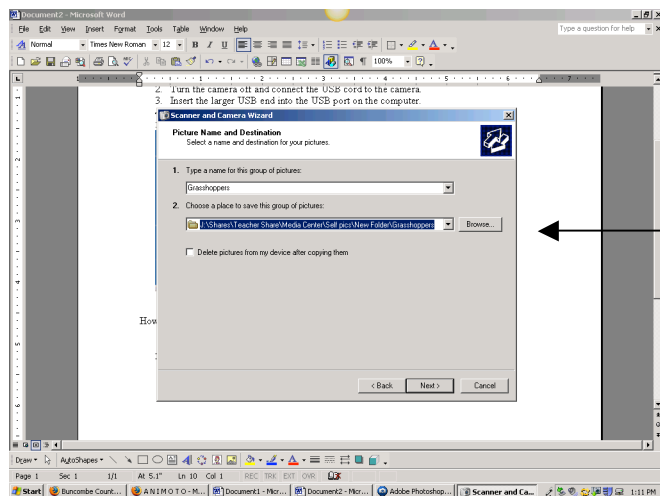


Downloading your pictures to your My Documents folder:

1. Take pictures with your digital camera.
2. Turn the camera off and connect the USB cord to the camera.
3. Insert the larger USB end into the USB port on the computer.
4. Turn the camera on.
5. Microsoft scanner and camera wizard should open. Choose “Scanner and Camera.”



Make sure you choose Scanner and Camera Wizard.



Browse for H://(your name).
You might want to make a new folder for the pictures.

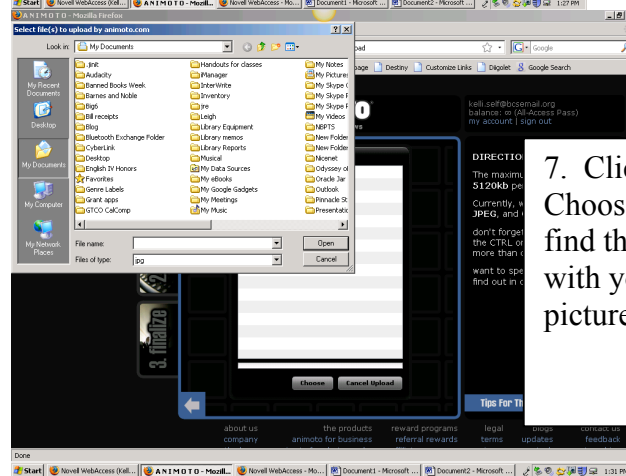
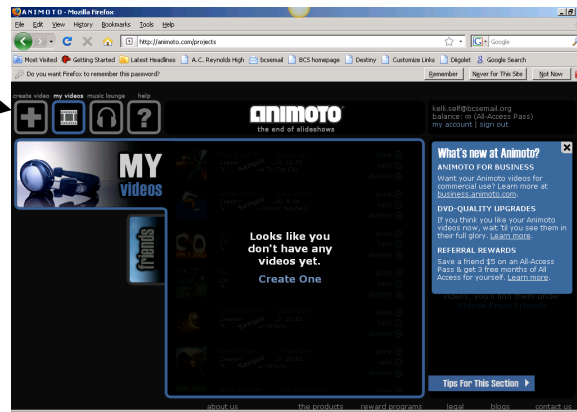
6. Check “delete pictures from device” when they begin to download.
7. If you don’t have enough space on your H:// drive you might have to download them to a flash drive.
8. If you choose to use pictures from the Internet, images must be in jpeg or gif formats and no larger than 5MB in size. Make sure to CITE YOUR SOURCE!

How to Create an Animoto Presentation:

1. Go to ([insert current link](#)). This will take you to the free education version.
2. Enter your email address and create a password (this will be your login). Please write this info. down. You can use your school account or a personal account.
3. Enter your name, location, birthday, accept the terms of service and type in the challenge words (if you can't read them, click the two arrows to get a new set).
4. Click "sign up."

5. Click Create Video

6. Click Upload or you can use their free images.



7. Click Choose and find the file with your pictures in it.

9. You have to click on the pictures to select the ones you want, then click "Open."
10. Wait for the pictures to download (might take a while depending on how many pics).
11. Make sure you put the pictures in order, rotate them, etc. before moving on to the next step.
12. At this point you can also add text between slides by clicking the big "T" at the bottom of the picture sorter view.
13. Choose your music (your own or from their music library).
 - a. The faster the music, the quicker the transition between photos.
 - b. Listen to the various tracks and then click "select."
 - c. Then "save and continue."
14. Give your video a title and a description.
15. Credit your group members as producers.
16. Leave the first screen green or choose one of your pictures for the intro. Slide.
17. Save and create your video.
18. Creating the video might take as many as twenty minutes. Be patient.
19. You can log out and check back later. It won't delete your video.
