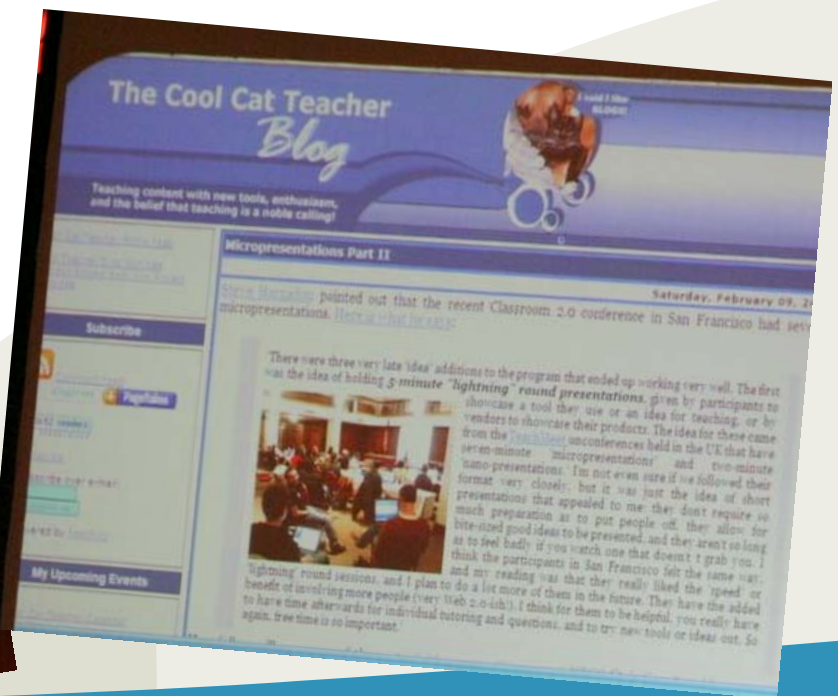
## Conference 2009 Opening Session

## Service Award

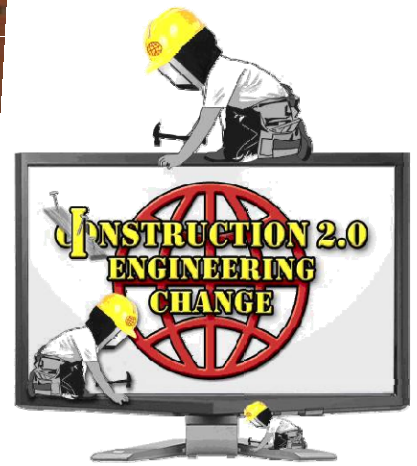
